



Royal Wedding in Windsor



Saturday 19th May 2018

The marriage of Prince Harry to Meghan Markle will take place at Windsor Castle on **Saturday 19th May**, and this will affect our services operating in the town. **Almost all roads within a mile of the castle will be closed to traffic from 2200 on Friday evening until late on Saturday.**

Please note the following changes to our services:

From 2200 on Friday 18th May until 2359 on Saturday 19th May

Service 2 (Dedworth-Windsor-Slough) will run non-stop between Orchard Avenue (Dedworth Road) and Windsor Road (McDonalds) in both directions.

Service 10 (Dedworth-Windsor-Heathrow) will run non-stop between Orchard Avenue (Dedworth Road) and Datchet Green in both directions.

Service 15/15A (Maidenhead-Eton-Slough) will not serve Eton High Street or Brocas Street, but will turn towards Slough at Eton College Chapel.

Service 16/16A (Maidenhead-Windsor) will run only as far as King Edward VII Hospital where it will terminate. Buses towards Maidenhead will start from King Edward VII Hospital.

Service 600 (Windsor-Legoland) will not operate on this day.

We anticipate that roads around Windsor will get very congested at times and delays could occur with the diverted services.

If you are intending to use the bus to get to Windsor on the day, please be mindful that we are unable to get close to the town centre and there will be a walk for you to reach your destination.

There is also a rehearsal taking place on Thursday 17th May which will also affect services between 0900 and 1400. At this time, the above changes will also be implemented except Services 2/10 will additionally serve Clarence Road and Arthur Road bus stops in both directions (and the Charles Street bus stop towards Dedworth) and services 15/15A will run normally.
